Tenders are hereby invited for the **supply of speed measuring equipment (laser and fixed and mobile cameras), accompanying back office administrative functions or the training to accomplish and logistical support for serving section 54 notices or the training to accomplish**, to Thembelihle Local Municipality.

We intend providing the service ourselves or appoint a service provider for a period of three (3) years

The TECHNICAL COMMITTEE FOR STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL AND TRAFFIC CONTROL EQUIPMENT (TCSP) guidelines and regulations will apply to the terms and conditions of any items and/or services purchased or any lease and/or service level agreements eventually signed.

The tender award for speed measuring equipment (with specifically the fixed and/or mobile cameras), will become effective when written confirmation is received from the Directorate of Public Prosecutions following the affirmation or granting of approval/permission.

A compulsory briefing session will be held on **26 March 2014** at **10h00** at the offices of Thembelihle Local Municipality, Church Street, Hopetown.

Submissions must be accompanied by:

- A) proof that equipment to be used comply with SANS 1795
- B) proof that The data capturing and recording devices for speed measurements, both manual and automated SME operations, produce a photograph/image showing at least the following information:
  - (i) the date of offence
  - (ii) the time of offence
  - (iii) the speed measured
  - (iv) the location description
  - (v) the offending vehicle clearly identifiable.

Tenders must be submitted on the original documents and remain valid for ninety (90) days after the closing date of the tender. Payments must be made by cash or EFT payable to the Thembelihle local municipality. **No e-mailed/ faxed documents will be accepted from any prospective bidder.** Additional sets of tender documents are available at a cost of R200-00 per set. The tender documents will be available from the **18th of March 2014.**

Fully completed tender documents must be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the tender box in the foyer at the Thembelihle Local Municipal Offices, Corner Mark And Church Streets, Hopetown not later than time and date stipulated or be posted to reach the tender box, Thembelihle Local Municipality, P/Bag X3, Hopetown, 8750 before the specified closing date and time. The envelopes must be endorsed clearly with the number, title, tenderer's name and closing date and time of the tender as above.

The tender will be evaluated on the 80/20 preference points system as prescribed by the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 5 of 2000.

Receipts will be issued on request only for tenders handed in during office hours from Mondays to Fridays. Receipts will not be issued for tenders placed in the tender box after hours or which are received by postal mail.

The tender box will be emptied just after 12:00 on the closing date as above, hereafter all bids will be opened in public. **Late tenders or tenders submitted by e-mail or fax will under no circumstances be accepted.**

The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

It is expected of all bidders who are not yet registered on the municipality's accredited supplier database to register without delay on the prescribed form. The municipality reserves the right not to award tenders to bidders who are not registered on the database.
