Thembelihle Local Municipality invites all prospective Service Providers to submit their proposals for the provision of Occupational Health and Safety services. All the prospective bidders must adhere to the specifications below. The Construction Health and Safety Agent as a specified category in terms of section 18 (1) (c) of the Project and Construction Management Professions Act No. 48 of 2000 must be registered with SACPCMP and certified proof must be attached.

The duties of the Agent will be as follows:

- audit the Contractor's compliance with the requirements of this specification prior to the commencement of any physical construction activities on the site;
- accept or reject all safety plans, giving reasons for rejecting such plans;
- monitor the effective implementation of all safety plans; conduct periodic and random audits on the health and safety file to establish compliance with the requirements of this specification;
- visit the site at regular intervals to conduct site inspections, and based upon such visits issue, wherever necessary, Improvement Notices, Contravention Notices and Prohibition Notices, to the Contractor or any of the Contractor's subcontractors with a copy to the Project Manager and, where relevant, to the contractor.

The duration of the Contract will be as for the duration of the construction works.

Quotations must be submitted on the original documents and remain valid for ninety (90) days after the closing date of the bid request. Enquiries pertaining to the specifications can be addressed to Mr Stephen Marufu at telephone (053) 203 0951. A set of quotation documents is available on the municipality's website and can be downloaded at no cost.

Fully completed quotation documents must be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the tender box in the Foyer at the Thembelihle Local Municipal offices corner Mark and Church Streets, Hopetown not later than time and date stipulated or be mailed to reach the Tender Box, Thembelihle Local Municipality, P/Bag X3, Hopetown, 8750 before the specified closing date and time. The envelopes must be endorsed clearly with the number, title, bidder's name and closing date and time of the quotation as above.

The quotations will be further evaluated on the 80/20 Preference Points system as prescribed by the Revised Preferential Procurement Policy Framework of 2017.

The tender box will be emptied just after 12:00 on the closing date as above, hereafter all bids will be opened in public. Late quotations or quotations submitted by e-mail or fax will under no circumstances be accepted.

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to readvertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

It is expected of all Bidders to be registered on the Central Supplier Database and on Municipality's Accredited Supplier Database. The Municipality reserves the right not to award tenders to Bidders who are not registered on these Databases.

6. MBD9: CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION

- 1 This Municipal Bidding Document (MBD) must form part of all bids¹ invited.
- Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging).² Collusive bidding is a *pe se* prohibition meaning that it cannot be justified under any grounds.
- Municipal Supply Regulation 38 (1) prescribes that a supply chain management policy must provide measures for the combating of abuse of the supply chain management system, and must enable the accounting officer, among others, to:
 - a. take all reasonable steps to prevent such abuse;
 - b. reject the bid of any bidder if that bidder or any of its directors has abused the supply chain management system of the municipality or municipal entity or has committed any improper conduct in relation to such system; and
 - c. cancel a contract awarded to a person if the person committed any corrupt or fraudulent act during the bidding process or the execution of the contract.

² Bid rigging (or collusive bidding) occurs when businesses, that would otherwise be expected to compete, secretly conspire to raise prices or lower the quality of goods and / or services for purchasers who wish to acquire goods and / or services through a bidding process. Bid rigging is, therefore, an agreement between competitors not to compete.

- 6. The bidder has arrived at the accompanying bid independently from, and without consultation, communication, agreement or arrangement with any competitor. However communication between partners in a joint venture or consortium³ will not be construed as collusive bidding.
- 7. In particular, without limiting the generality of paragraphs 6 above, there has been no consultation, communication, agreement or arrangement with any competitor regarding:
 - (a) prices;
 - (b) geographical area where product or service will be rendered (market allocation)
 - (c) methods, factors or formulas used to calculate prices;
 - (d) the intention or decision to submit or not to submit, a bid;
 - (e) the submission of a bid which does not meet the specifications and conditions of the bid; or
 - (f) bidding with the intention not to win the bid.
- 8. In addition, there have been no consultations, communications, agreements or arrangements with any competitor regarding the quality, quantity, specifications and conditions or delivery particulars of the products or services to which this bid invitation relates.
- 9. The terms of the accompanying bid have not been, and will not be, disclosed by the bidder, directly or indirectly, to any competitor, prior to the date and time of the official bid opening or of the awarding of the contract.

³ Joint venture or Consortium means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract.

10. I am aware that, in addition and without prejudice to any other remedy provided to combat any restrictive practices related to bids and contracts, bids that are suspicious will be reported to the Competition Commission for investigation and possible imposition of administrative penalties in terms of section 59 of the Competition Act No 89 of 1998 and or may be reported to the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for criminal investigation and or may be restricted from conducting business with the public sector for a period not exceeding ten (10) years in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act No 12 of 2004 or any other applicable legislation.
