The envelopes must be endorsed clearly with the number, title and closing date of the tender as above.

Thembelihle Local Municipality reserves the right to request some or all tenderers to give presentations at a time, date and venue to be determined by the municipality to provide additional information and elaborating on their tenders.

Tenders will be pre-evaluated on functionality and bidders scoring less than 70 out of 100 points for functionality will not be considered for further evaluation.

The tender will be further evaluated on the 80/20 Preference Points system as prescribed by the Revised Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 5 of 2017.

The tender box will be emptied just after 12h00 on the closing date as above, hereafter all bids will be opened in public. Late tenders or tenders submitted by e-mail or fax will under no circumstances be accepted.

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.
