The envelopes/email must be endorsed clearly with the number, title, bidder's name and closing date and time of the quotation as above. Quotations must be emailed to quotations@thembelihlemunicipality.gov.za

The quotations will be evaluated on the 80/20 Preference Points system as prescribed by the Revised Preferential Procurement Policy Framework of 2017.

The tender box will be emptied just after 11:00 on the closing date as above, hereafter all bids will be opened in public. <u>Late quotations submitted by e-mail will under no circumstances be</u> accepted.

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

It is expected of all Bidders who are not yet registered on the Municipality's Accredited Supplier Database and on the CSD to register without delays. The Municipality reserves the right not to award bids to Bidders who are not registered on the CSD.

- Prices quoted must be inclusive of VAT
- Bids will be evaluated in accordance with Method 2: Financial offer and preference, qualifying offers will be evaluated according to the 80/20 point system, where the financial offer will account for 80 points and preferences for 20 points. All the returnable forms must be completed and submitted with the bid. Bidders are required to, together with their bids, submit a valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate or certified copies and or an original Sworn Affidavit thereof to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims
- Bids that are late or incomplete will not be considered, whilst the lowest or only bid will not necessarily be accepted.
- An original tax clearance certificate, and/or the document issued by SARS indicating the tax clearance PIN or CSD MAAA nr must be provided
- Bids must be accompanied with documentation that indicate strength test of bricks and Kerbs

6. MBD9: CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION

- 1 This Municipal Bidding Document (MBD) must form part of all bids¹ invited.
- Section 4 (1) (b) (iii) of the Competition Act No. 89 of 1998, as amended, prohibits an agreement between, or concerted practice by, firms, or a decision by an association of firms, if it is between parties in a horizontal relationship and if it involves collusive bidding (or bid rigging).² Collusive bidding is a *pe se* prohibition meaning that it cannot be justified under any grounds.
- Municipal Supply Regulation 38 (1) prescribes that a supply chain management policy must provide measures for the combating of abuse of the supply chain management system, and must enable the accounting officer, among others, to:
 - a. take all reasonable steps to prevent such abuse;
 - b. reject the bid of any bidder if that bidder or any of its directors has abused the supply chain management system of the municipality or municipal entity or has committed any improper conduct in relation to such system; and
 - c. cancel a contract awarded to a person if the person committed any corrupt or fraudulent act during the bidding process or the execution of the contract.

² Bid rigging (or collusive bidding) occurs when businesses, that would otherwise be expected to compete, secretly conspire to raise prices or lower the quality of goods and / or services for purchasers who wish to acquire goods and / or services through a bidding process. Bid rigging is, therefore, an agreement between competitors not to compete.

- 6. The bidder has arrived at the accompanying bid independently from, and without consultation, communication, agreement or arrangement with any competitor. However communication between partners in a joint venture or consortium³ will not be construed as collusive bidding.
- 7. In particular, without limiting the generality of paragraphs 6 above, there has been no consultation, communication, agreement or arrangement with any competitor regarding:
 - (a) prices;
 - (b) geographical area where product or service will be rendered (market allocation)
 - (c) methods, factors or formulas used to calculate prices;
 - (d) the intention or decision to submit or not to submit, a bid;
 - (e) the submission of a bid which does not meet the specifications and conditions of the bid; or
 - (f) bidding with the intention not to win the bid.
- 8. In addition, there have been no consultations, communications, agreements or arrangements with any competitor regarding the quality, quantity, specifications and conditions or delivery particulars of the products or services to which this bid invitation relates.
- 9. The terms of the accompanying bid have not been, and will not be, disclosed by the bidder, directly or indirectly, to any competitor, prior to the date and time of the official bid opening or of the awarding of the contract.

I am aware that, in addition and without prejudice to any other remedy provided to combat any restrictive practices related to bids and contracts, bids that are suspicious will be reported to the Competition Commission for investigation and possible imposition of administrative penalties in terms of section 59 of the Competition Act No 89 of 1998 and or may be reported to the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for criminal investigation and or may be restricted from conducting business with the public sector for a period not exceeding ten (10) years in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act No 12 of 2004 or any other applicable legislation.
