- Communicating with the immediate superior on aspects pertaining to end user computing and/ or equipment/ application requirements
- Diagnosing specific software related problems, interacting with vendors/consultants on corrective measures/ applicability of suggested solutions
- Installing/configuring set-up commands, testing and solving of logs and conducting analysis and evaluation on the functionality of application software
- Maintaining data dictionaries/ directories and controlling the distribution and retention

- Performing upgrades and repairs to components/ peripheral devices
 - Setting up, installing and testing new units prior to handover and monitoring functionality in the live environment
 - Assessing and presenting to the immediate superior the need for new software, upgrades and disposal.
 - Evaluating competency level of end users and conducting demonstration or instruction based training to improve capability.
 - Install and test network cables by physically laying the cables to the new network points.
 - Install couplings to linking cables and install fixtures to network
 - Ensure that work is always done accurately and tidy.
 - Perform inspections of the existing network cables periodically.
 - Perform maintenance where necessary, e.g. where cables are hanging loose from walls, etc.
 - Connect new computers to the network, configure network cards by using top up protocol.
 - Allocate network name to the computer and link to the relevant domain' (SKDR1).
 - Performs 'wireless' links.
 - Keep register of IP addresses to prevent conflict.
 - Make sure that network cables are clearly marked, especially at the switch hubs.
