TENDER NUMBER: TLM 03/2025/26: ELECTRIFICATION OF 134 **HOUSEHOLDS IN HILLSIDE - HOPETOWN**

Thembelihle Local Municipality hereby invites tenders in terms of Section 83 of the Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000 (as amended), and Sections 110 and 112 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, Act 56 of 2003, from suitably qualified and experienced contractors with a CIDB grading of 4EP or higher for the Electrification of 134 Households in Hillside (Hopetown), located within the Thembelihle Local Municipality, Hopetown, Northern Cape.

1. Project Overview

This project entails the electrification of 134 households in Hillside, Hopetown, including the supply, installation, testing, and commissioning of materials and equipment for LV and MV reticulation, pole-mounted transformers, pole top boxes, service connections, prepaid meters, earthing, and associated civil works, as detailed in Tender Document TLM 03/2025/26.

The project aligns with the Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP), prioritising local labour, skills transfer, and SMME subcontracting to promote local economic development within the Thembelihle Local Municipal area.

2. Scope of Work (Summary)

- Construction of MV and LV networks with conductor stringing and tensioning
- Installation of pole-mounted distribution transformers (50kVA/100kVA/200kVA)
- Pole top boxes, prepaid metering systems, and service connections to households
- Earthing and protection installations
- Testing, commissioning, and network energisation
- Trenching, backfilling, reinstatement, and site clearing
- Community labour management and EPWP compliance

3. Tender Document Availability

4. Compulsory Briefing Session

A Compulsory briefing session will be held at 10:00 a.m on Tuesday, 5 of August 2025, at the THEMBELIHLE TECHNICAL SERVICES BOARDROOM in HOPETOWN (GPS COORDINATE: S 29° 37′ 40′S; 24° 04′ 55′E).

DOORS WILL BE CLOSED AT 10H00 SHARP. Tenderers, who do not attend the compulsory briefing session, will expose their tenders to rejection. Tenderers who arrive late will not be allowed to participate in the tender process.

5. Tender Document and Submission Details

Fully completed documents must be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the tender box in the Foyer at the Thembelihle Local Municipal offices or mailed to reach the tender box at corner of Mark and Church Streets, Hopetown, not later than the time and date stipulated or be mailed to reach the Tender Box, before the specified closing date and time. The envelopes must be endorsed clearly with the number, title, bidder's name and closing date and time of the tender as above.

Telephonic, facsimile, email, and/or late bids will not be accepted. Tenders will be **opened immediately thereafter in public**.

Bids must remain valid for a period of ninety (90) days after the closing date of the bid.

The tender box will be emptied just after 12:00 on the closing date as above, thereafter all bids will be opened in public.

6. The tenders will be evaluated on a 2-Stage Process:

Stage 1: Functionality
